### **Open Enrollment Key Information**

Monday, October 30, to Friday, November 17, 2023

• In mid-October:

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- Open Enrollment materials mailed to home address.
- Benefits information, including brochures, posted to HR website: <u>humanresources.columbia.edu/oe</u>.
- Make changes and/or through CUBES, the Columbia University Benefits Enrollment System.
- Consider electronic document delivery for benefits-related materials.
- During Open Enrollment, the Columbia Benefits Service Center is open 9 a.m. – 5 p.m., Monday through Friday.

**Remember:** The choices you make during Open Enrollment will stay in effect all year—unless you experience a Qualified Life Status Change.



### What's New for 2024



- Aetna Dental PPO new maximum. Annual maximums will increase from \$1,500 to \$1,750 for dental services in the Columbia Preferred Dental Network and annual maximums will increase from \$1,250 to \$1,500 in the Aetna Dental Network. The Out-of- Network annual maximum will also increase from \$1,250 to \$1,500.
- Orthodontic Services. New lifetime maximum per person for orthodontic services. The lifetime maximum has increased from \$1,500 to \$1,750 in the Columbia Preferred Dental Network and from \$1,250 to \$1,500 in the Aetna Dental Network. The Out-of- Network annual maximum will also increase from \$1,250 to \$1,500.
- Healthcare Flexible Spending Account (HCFSA). New annual maximums will increase from \$3,050 to \$3,200. Carryover of unused amounts increases in 2024 from \$610 to \$640.
- Child Care Benefit. Eligible employees can elect to receive up to \$5,000 contribution from Columbia to Dependent Care FSA.
- Transit/Parking Reimbursement Program (T/PRP). 2024 monthly contributions limit increases from \$300 to \$315





### What's New for 2024

- Voluntary Retirement Savings Plan (VRSP). 2024 base contribution maximum will increase from \$22,500 to \$23,000.
- **New legal services with MetLife.** Access to expert legal help so you can navigate life's big moments confidently. To learn more, attend the virtual information session or benefits expos.
- Voluntary benefits with MetLife. Obtain critical Illness, accident and hospital indemnity insurance with MetLife. Current policyholders will automatically be enrolled with MetLife January 1, 2024.
- **One Pass**. New Fitness Option for faculty and staff offering a variety of membership options for different gyms, fitness classes, virtual classes and grocery and home essential delivery.
- Introducing Maven Milk. A reliable solution that makes it possible for new parents to continue breastfeeding while they travel for University business.
- **NUSS –** University contributions for Healthcare Flexible Spending Accounts will increase for 2024 for both full-time and part-time eligible employees.
- Medical and Dental Plan Contributions. Medical plans and Aetna Columbia Dental Plan contributions will increase.











### **MetLife Legal Services**

Legal help can be valuable at every stage of life, whether you're getting married, sending kids off to college or retiring and planning for the future. Having access to expert legal help allows you to navigate life's milestones confidently. The University's Legal plan is provided by MetLife.

#### What is covered:

- Network attorneys are available in person, by phone or by email and online tools to do it yourself—make it easy to get legal help.
- You will have a choice of which attorney to use from the MetLife network of prequalified attorneys, or use an attorney outside of the network and be reimbursed some of the cost.
- Unlimited access to attorneys for all legal matters covered under the plan.

#### Who is eligible:

• University employees, spouses, eligible children, parents, parents-in-law, and grandparents can be covered.

• Pay for coverage with payroll deductions.

Maven Milk is a breast milk shipping service that provides breastfeeding parents with the ability to send or bring milk back home to their baby when traveling for work anywhere around the world.

Maven Milk has travel kit options that make traveling and shipping breast milk easy. You can choose between three convenient, reliable, and safe ways to ship breast milk when traveling for work:


- Pump + Post kit: Overnight shipping of up to 36 oz. of breast milk anywhere in the U.S.
- Pump + Carry kit: TSA-friendly tote with foam ice packs to bring breast milk home on short domestic flights or day trips.
- Pump + Check kit: A cooler that can be checked in with your luggage that packs up to 270 oz. of breast milk, used for international or longer domestic trips.

Maven also provides on-demand and unlimited appointments with lactation consultants. What's included:

- Education and preparation while you are pregnant.
- Observing latch technique and provide real-time guidance.


