Did You Notice?

Type of activity: Icebreaker

Participants: 2-20 Timing: 10-30 Minutes

Materials: Index cards, pens Cost: \$0

Key themes: Icebreaker, Getting to Know Others



Instructions:

- The person leading the activity will create a list of questions that participants will respond to. The activity leader should write one question on a sheet of paper or index card.
- Place the index cards at the center of a table.
- Each person (in random order) selects the topics listed on the card. The person will then read the question written on the card and share an answer.
- Complete as multiple rounds or until all questions are exhausted.

Sample questions for cards:

- What color are the floor tiles in reception?
- What books/literature/magazines are stored in the reception area?
- What is your office or cubicle number?
- What is the number of people who work on your office floor?

Debrief

This activity can help bring awareness to team member's work, day-to-day activities, and personal environment.

Optional: The activity lead can assign points to correct responses. The participant with the most responses wins.
