

How to Register via Quest Registration site for New Participants

- Visit My.QuestForHealth.com
- Use the **Create Account** area, enter the registration key (**columbiauniversity2025**), and select the **Register Now** button
- Once you've established an account during the initial registration process, use the **Log In** area for any subsequent entries into the site. Enter your **username** and **password** and select the green **Log In** button
 - If you've forgotten your login information, use the **username** link to retrieve your username or the **password** link to reset your password

You must be 18 years of age or older. As applicable for the program(s) available to you, you consent to the collection of a blood sample from a fingerstick or from the arm (venipuncture); capillary blood collection from the arm using the Tasso device; measurement of blood pressure, height, weight, waist and/or hip measurements; the collection of a cheek swab or blood sample for the purpose of cotinine testing to detect tobacco use; the collection of a nasal swab for the purposes of performing a test for the detection of COVID-19 and/or to a blood draw to determine whether you have developed antibodies to COVID-19; and/or the collection of a fecal sample for Colorectal Cancer screening. You understand that collection of a blood sample involves certain potential risks that may include but are not limited to prolonged bleeding, fainting or feeling lightheaded, bruising and multiple sticks. If the program includes the reporting of results at the point of collection, this data should be considered preliminary, as the

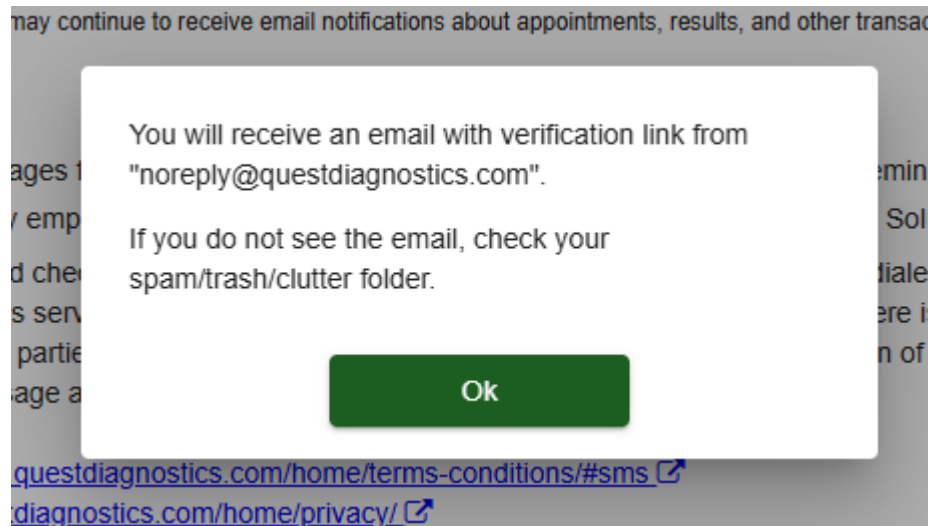

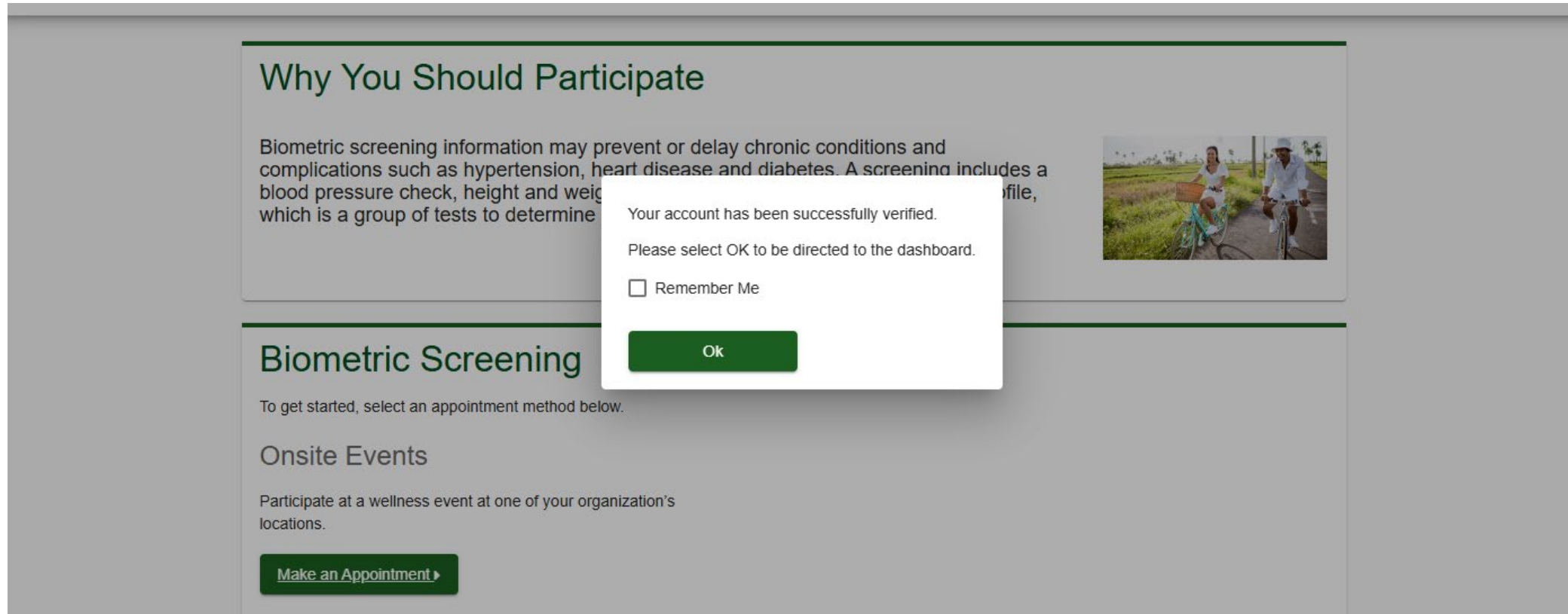

Why You Should Participate

Biometric screening information may prevent or delay chronic conditions and complications such as hypertension, heart disease and diabetes. A screening includes a blood pressure check, height and weight measurement, and a lipid and glucose profile, which is a group of tests to determine the risk of coronary heart disease.

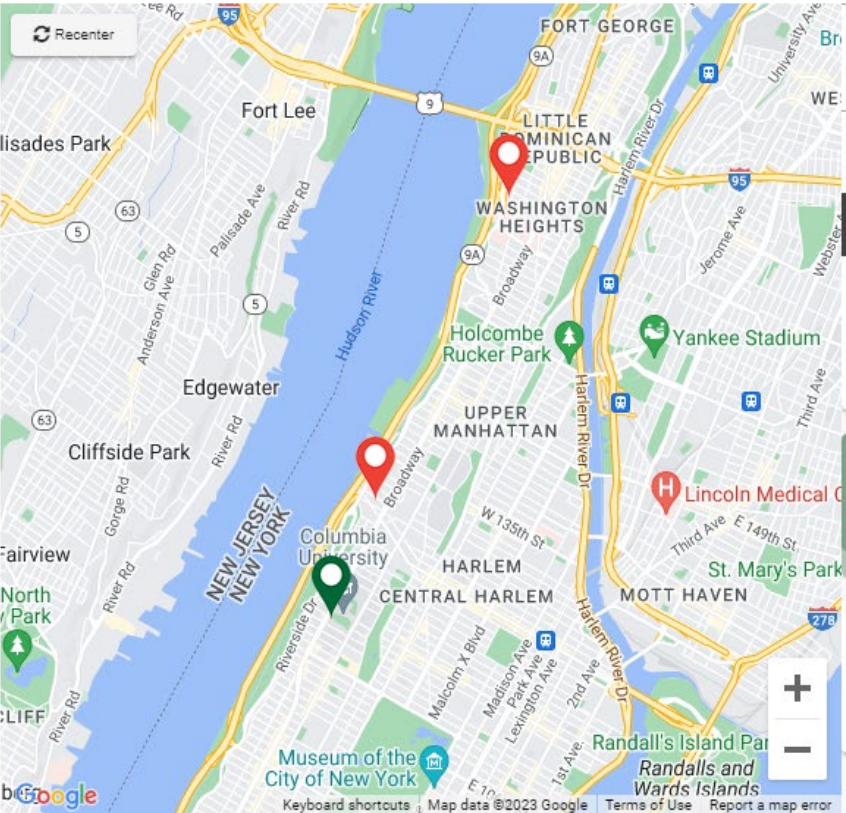
